

# Pandemonium! at Global Finals 2014



Welcome and congratulations to you and your team for qualifying for Global Finals 2014! Below is some general information that will hopefully make Pandemonium a great adventure for you and your team. Please join us at the **Team Manager meeting Tuesday May 20, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Knoxville Convention Center (KCC) Ballrooms ABC**. After this meeting, there will be a separate breakout session for just **Pandemonium** Team Managers in KCC 301DE. You are highly encouraged to attend both meetings to receive all the critical information about Global Finals!

**Check-In/Prep Area:** All teams must check in at least **twenty minutes** before their scheduled Presentation Time. Parents and supporters will enter through the Audience Entrance to watch the Presentation. This is a separate entrance from the teams.

## What the team MAY bring to the Prep Area:

- One 1 liter or 1 quart closed plastic bag of Stage Makeup and applicators. In addition, the team may bring materials for cleaning up after its Presentation. As a reminder, these cleaning materials for the Stage Makeup do not have to fit inside the 1 liter or 1 quart size bag AND these items may NOT be used in the Skit in anyway.
- Floor covering no smaller than 36in x 36in (91.5cm x 91.5cm) for floor protection in the area where they will apply the Stage Makeup in the Start Area. This must be a single sheet or tarp.
- 5 copies of the Tournament Data Forms
- 1 copy of the Declaration of Independence
- Team Identification Sign
- Research Notes
- 1 clean copy of the Challenge

**Preparation time:** During the 4-minute and 1-minute Preparation times, teams may ask the Timekeeper/Announcer for remaining time. The audience should be quiet so teams may work without disruption. Team Manager(s) and/or Audience interacting with the Team during Preparation time is Interference and not allowed.

## After the Presentation:

Before you and your team leave the Presentation Site, remember that your team is responsible for removing all of the team's possession from the site and cleaning up any Stage Makeup.

## **A Reminder of Pandemonium Published Clarifications:**

#1 - August 28, 2013

In the Challenge, the Putting It All Together pie chart should eliminate Team Choice Elements and should read:

THE CENTRAL CHALLENGE – 75%

INSTANT CHALLENGE – 25%

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#2 - September 10, 2013

Destination Imagination is not just a tournament. We are committed to teaching the Creative Process, which consists of 6 stages. Reflection is an important part of this process. Page 3 of the Tournament Data Form is designed to encourage and help teams to reflect on their journey through the Creative Process. All Tournament Data Forms are only informational. Teams should bring copies of the forms to their DI tournaments, but they will not be scored and there will be no deductions for missing or incomplete forms. They are used only to help the Appraisers as they look at Challenge requirements.

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#3 - October 4, 2013

In the Challenge, section A.3.c.vii states that the team must bring a protective floor covering which the team will use while applying Stage Makeup. In addition to the floor covering, teams may also bring protective team member covering(s) to protect the clothing of any team member applying or receiving Stage Makeup. Like the floor covering, the protective team member covering(s) does not have to fit in the 1 liter or 1 quart bag for the Stage Makeup. The protective team member covering(s) may be used if the team applies Stage Makeup to a team member during the Skit, but it may not be used in any way as a part of the team's Presentation.

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#4 - February 5, 2014

In the Challenge, section A.3.c.iii should read: The team will use its randomly-selected style of Stage Makeup to create, develop, and/or enhance only one Skit character. This Skit character is the team's choice and may be any character in the team's skit. The team's one Skit character may consist of one or more team members, but only one team member can have Stage Makeup applied.

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**On Saturday morning (May 24)**, Knoxville hosts the Tennessee Sports Medicine EXPO - 10K, 5K & Fun Walk road race until about noon. Many roads around the UT campus will be closed or have limited access. All teams presenting Saturday morning should plan on delays in travel to and from the Alumni Memorial Building.

### **Tournament Data Form Page 3**

We will be using Page 3 of the Tournament Data Forms: The Creative Process for a research project later in the year. These forms will be collected in the Prep Area. Please be sure your team members reflect thoughtfully on how they experienced the creative process as they solved the Team Challenge. Evaluation is an important part of this process, and their thoughts will help us to make the program stronger and more meaningful through academic research.
